## Meeting reports

The Editors welcome the submission of short reports on recent meetings of interest to microbiologists. The decision whether to publish these is made by the Editor-in-Chief. It is advisable to contact the Editor-in-Chief (via the Editorial Office: [micro@sgm.ac.uk](mailto:micro@sgm.ac.uk)) with a proposal before submitting a report.

Meeting Reports should give a brief account of *highlights* from the meeting, and include some comment on their significance. They should not attempt to cover every contribution. All the contributors whose work is mentioned in the report must be named.

Meeting Reports should not exceed 2500 words (approximately 4 printed pages). They must be submitted no more than 1 month after the date of the meeting, and will be given priority for publication.

Before submitting the Meeting Report, the author(s) of the report *must* obtain permission from both the meeting organizer and any participants whose work is mentioned (and if appropriate the meeting sponsor) to report results presented at the meeting. Confirmation of this will be required before publication.
